Project Overview

The City of Ellsworth seeks funding from the US Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration for funding available through the Airport Infrastructure Grant (AIG) program for the design and construction of a new 45' x 35'6" Snow Removal Equipment (SRE) Storage Facility that will be used to house an existing SRE Tractor and associated attachments previously purchased by the airports' use of FAA AIP Funding.

This opportunity is a discretionary BIL program with a local match requirement of 10% of the total project cost. The entity is requesting \$13,048.00 from the Build Kansas Fund. This request has the potential to unlock \$117,429.00 in federal funds.

The federal deadline was June 7, 2024, and this Build Kansas Fund application was received on June 4, 2024.

PROJECT: Snow Removal Equipment Building Construction
AIRPORT: Ellsworth Municipal Airport (9K7)
1. Objective: Construction of a new Snow Removal Equipment (SRE) Storage Facility in which existing SRE Equipment and attachments can be stored. Primary SRE Equipment includes an SRE Tractor Model TV145 New Holland with attachments such as a blade, snow blower, broom, snow pusher, and bucket. Construction includes a single vehicular garage door, a single pedestrian entrance door, concrete driveway and sidewalks for both doors, waterline connection to the new facility, electrical connection to the new facility, and new gravel to reconstruct the existing gravel drive disrupted with new construction activities.
2. Benefits Anticipated: Protection of SRE Equipment from weather elements and extension of serviceable lifespan.
3.
