Project Overview

The City of Hutchinson seeks funding from the Federal Aviation Administration for funding available through the Airport Infrastructure Grant (AIG) program for the construction of the general aviation apron taxilane at the Hutchinson Regional Airport (HUT)

This opportunity is a formula BIL program with a local match requirement of 10% of the total project cost. The entity is requesting \$97,888.00 from the Build Kansas Fund. This request has the potential to unlock \$881,000.00 in federal funds.

The deadline is July 12, 2024, and this Build Kansas Fund application was received on June 24, 2024.

Description of the Project

The City of Hutchinson, Kansas (City) and H.W. Lochner, Inc. (Lochner) entered into a contract for engineering design services for the construction of the general aviation apron taxilane at the Hutchinson Regional Airport (HUT).

Project Location, Analysis of Current Airfield Conditions, and Needs Addressed

The Hutchinson Regional Airport is located on the northeast side of the City of Hutchinson in central Reno County in south-central Kansas. The airport consists of three runways: asphalt Runway 4-22 (4,405' x 100'), asphalt Runway 13-31 (7,003' x 100'), and concrete Runway 17-35 (4,012' x 75'). Four Taxiways, A, B, C, and E, serve as access routes for aircraft to reach the three runways. The focus for this project will be the apron taxilane which will be classified as Taxiway Design Group (TDG) 2A.

Taxiway A1 connects users that frequent Midwest Malibu to Taxiway A, Runway 17-35, Runway 4-22, and Runway 13-31. In it's current orientation, when Midwest Malibu has aircraft in front of their hangar, aircraft that are coming from the fuel facility or the General Aviation (GA) apron cannot access the airfield. This project expands the apron enough such that Midwest Malibu can operate and not obstruct aircraft from maneuvering around the terminal area.

Expected Project Outcomes

This project features an apron taxilane expansion allowing "circular flow" to alleviate the issues previously described. The pavement section proposed features 8.5-inch-thick PCC atop a six-inch-thick aggregate base course atop a 12-inch-thick aggregate subbase course. Within the project area there is an electrical manhole, housing the airfield's extensive electrical infrastructure that needs to be adjusted to accommodate the different surface elevation post-construction. Proposed underdrains and French drains will shed any subsurface water from the pavement section.

Project Goals

Completing this project will allow "circular flow" within the terminal area while not obstructing the services provided by Midwest Malibu.
