

BIL Overview


- Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL)
 - AKA Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA)
- National Infrastructure Investment = \$1.2 Trillion across 5 years
 - Nearly 400 programs across 12 Federal Agencies
 - 60% Formula / 40% Discretionary





2 Match Support

- Average local match requirements for most BIL programs is 20%
- Potentially, if we invest \$200 million as the local match for projects that could return as much as \$800 million to Kansas for infrastructure projects.




Important notes

- Projects only receive funds <u>if awarded</u> a federal grant. Federal agencies make those selections.
- This is additive only. Communities can apply for federal grants without going through the Hub.




Supporting Transparency | BIL


BASE Unfunded Applications Review
